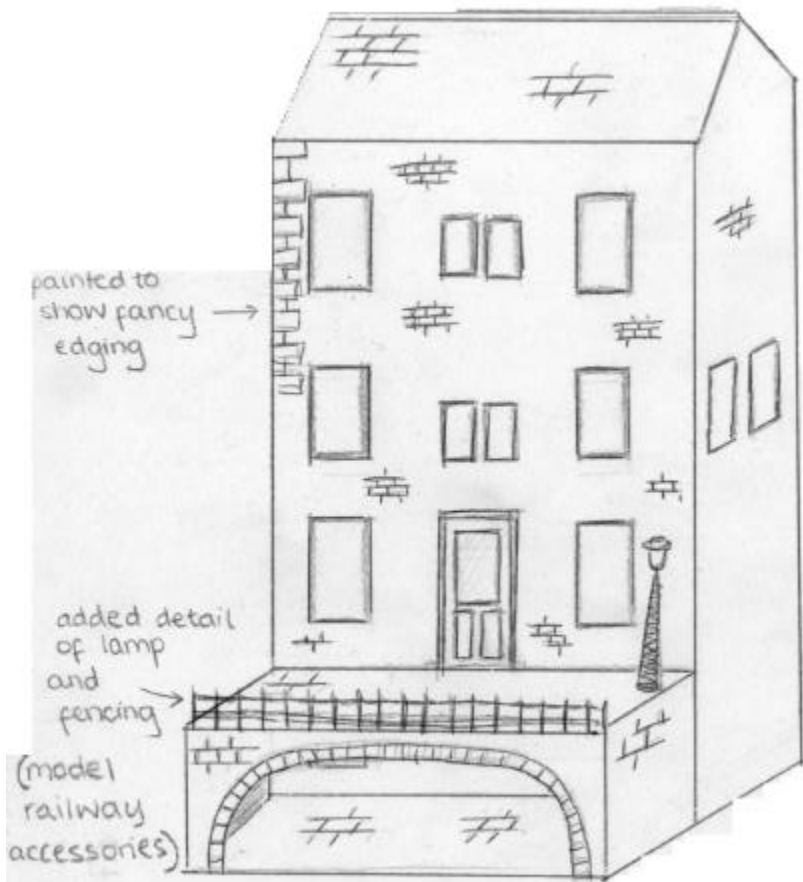


## DESIGN FOR A VICTORIAN MANSION



### Possible adaptations:

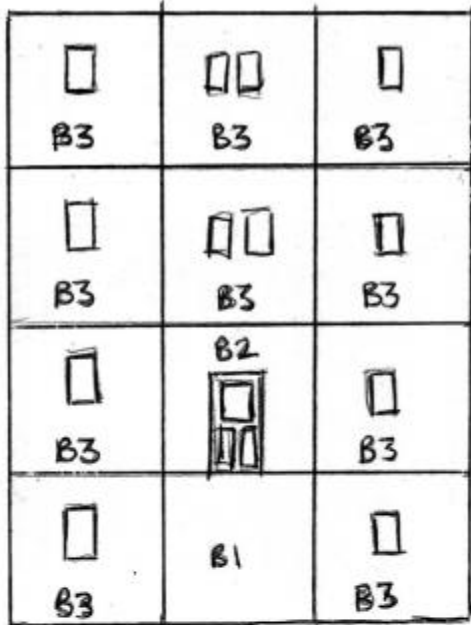
- many houses of the same design can be joined together to create a terrace or crescent.
- chimney can be added (R1)
- A door included underneath the bridge as an extra entrance to the house.
- use windows from B2 mould to give it a more modern appearance.
- steps added, going down from the street to the cellar.

### use of colours can be varied:

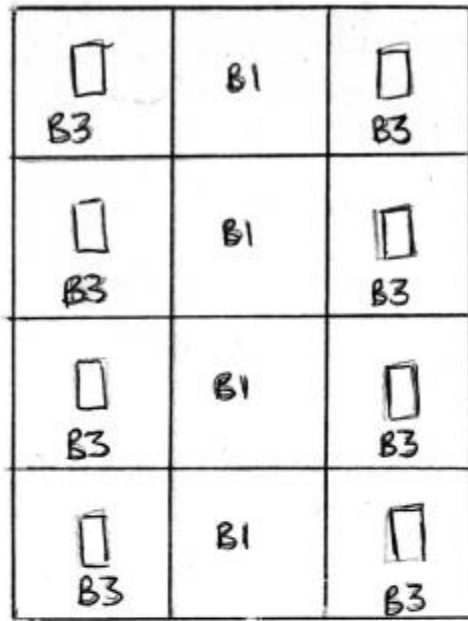
- white or cream paint can be used over the entire brick surface to achieve a very "classic Victorian" appearance.
- brickwork can be painted in normal colours - red/orange, etc.
- stonework on the street is intended as cobbles and can be painted as such.
- roof would usually be grey tiles, but can be varied.

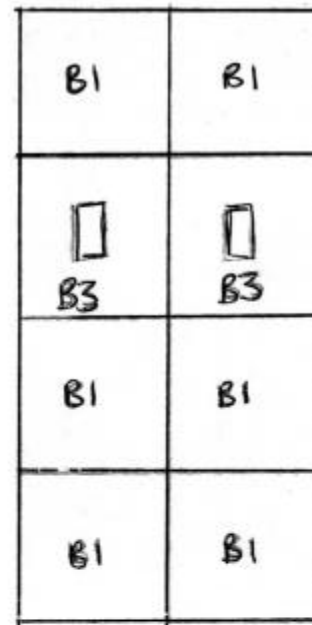

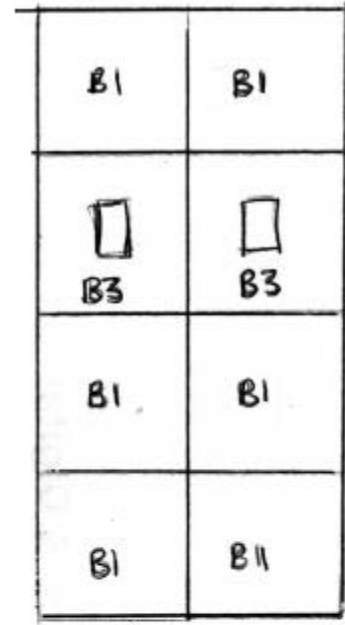

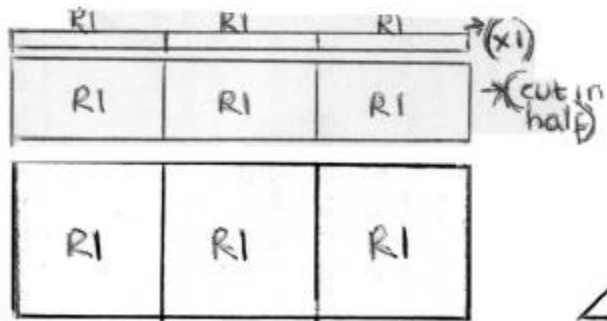

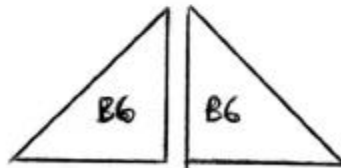

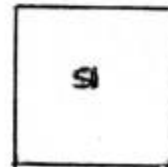

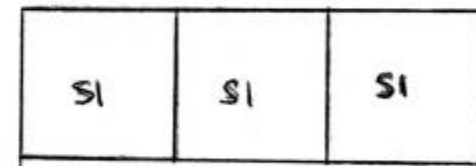
ROOF FRONT (x2)  
AND BACK



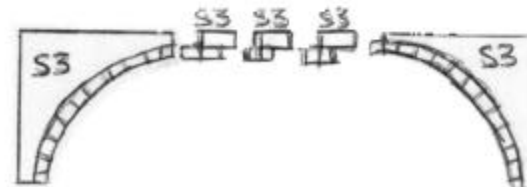
ROOF
