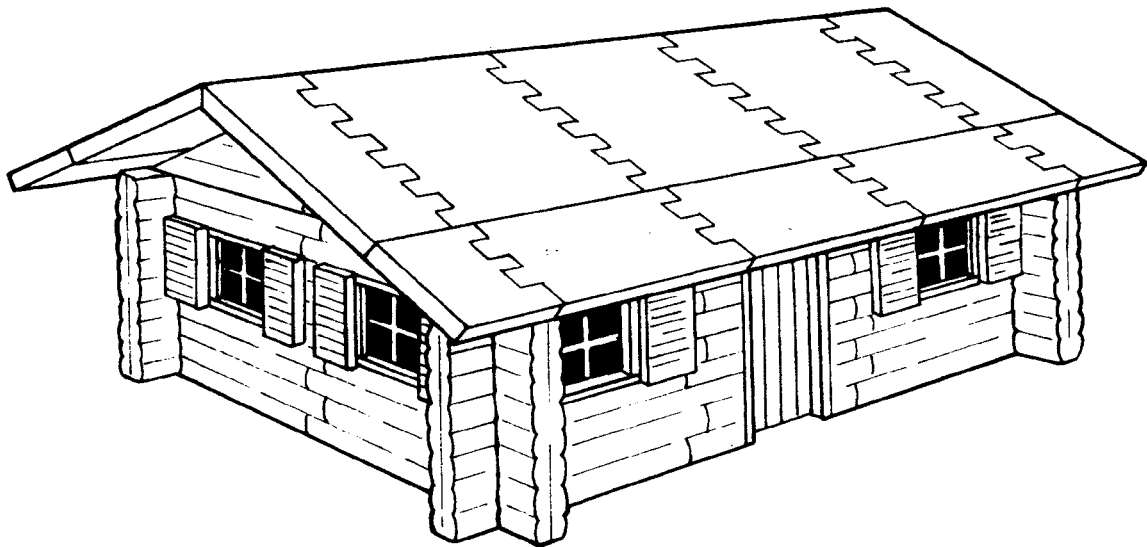

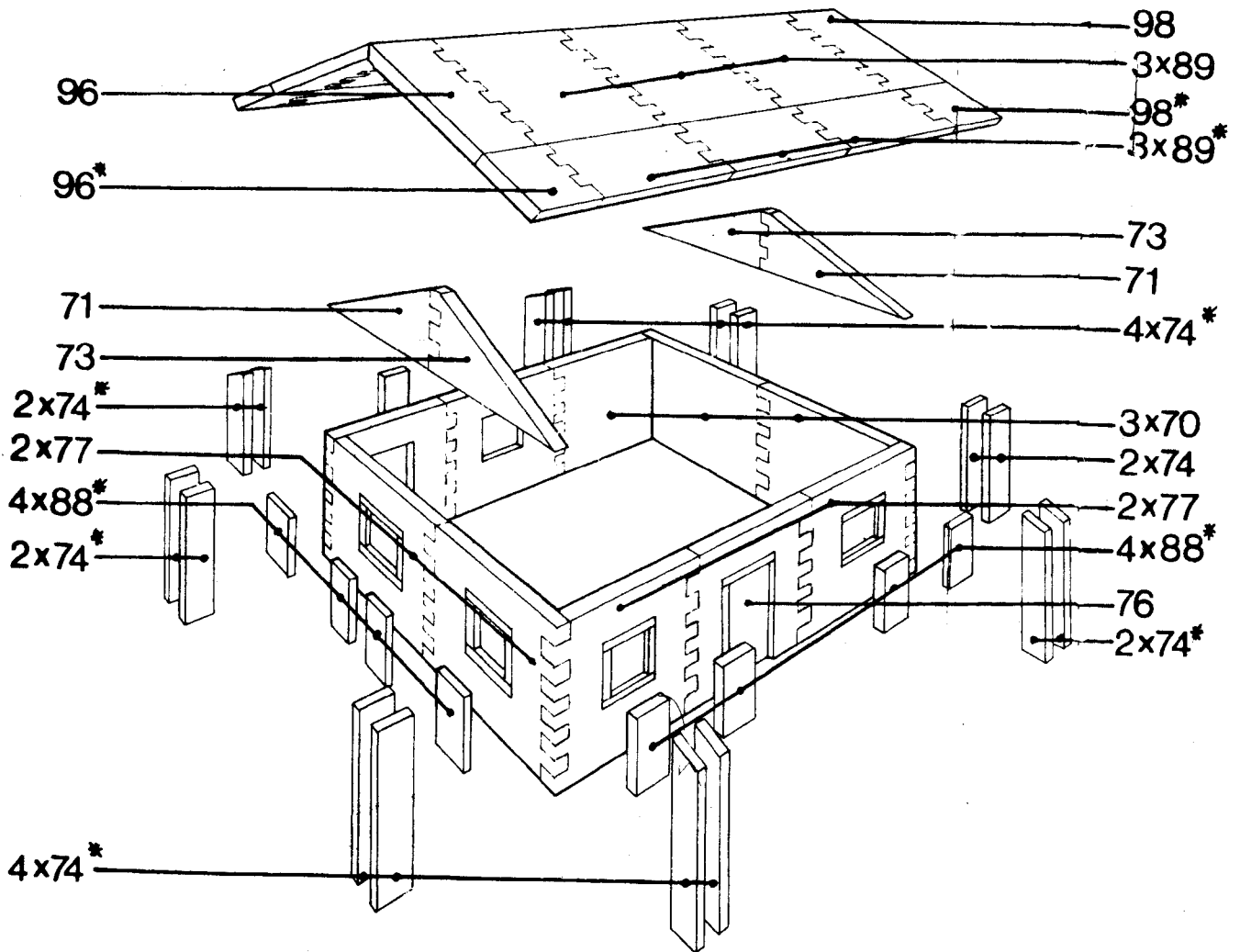

CHALET (variation of log cabin)



#173-Ch-1 p-3 Chalet (Variation of log cabin)

This shows you the small log cabin described in the instruction sheet can be easily made to represent a chalet.

1. Construct the main walls together with the eaves.
2. Glue castings 74 back to back and glue at corners to represent log extensions.
3. Make the shutters by trimming the links from castings 85 or 88 and cutting to length. Chamfer all back edges before glueing in place.
4. Make up roof panels. Chamfer the top edges so they fit together and chamfer all other edges so they appear thinner.
5. Paint to represent single logs and glue acetate windows in place.
